All proceeds from this one-day event will benefit the *Anoka County Brotherhood Council Food Shelf*.

Some 24 teams representing a variety of Anoka County businesses can participate. *All participants are asked to solicit pledges prior to the event*. Please refer to the pledge sheet enclosed for more details. In addition, everyone who attends the Bowl-A-Rama is asked to bring a *non-perishable food item*.

Furthermore, each year ACBC awards a traveling trophy to the team with the highest score. This year scores will be tallied as listed below:

Each team will play three games. At the completion of each game, each team member's scores will be added together and recorded. After all three games have been played, the team's total series will be added to the amount of pledges they turned in by the day of the event. The team with the highest score wins! **There will be no exceptions, only those pledges turned in the day of the event, or before, will be used to determine the final team scores.**

EXAMPLE: Out of all three games, **Team 1's** highest cumulative score was 560, and they turned in \$425 in pledges *by the day of the event*. Their total score is 985 (560+425). **Team 2's** highest cumulative score was 600 and turned in \$300 in pledges *by the day of the event*. Their final score is 900 (600+300). Team 1 wins as their total combined scores are higher than team 2. Team 1 wins the traveling trophy for the year.

Talk to your co-workers, friends and family and gather five bowlers to form your team. Feel free to form more than one team; simply copy the enclosed registration and pledge form. Registrations are accepted on a first-come basis, and lanes are filling up fast! *Please return your registration form(s) to Mark Muellenbach, 11397 274th ave Zimmerman MN 55398*. The event is coming quickly. There is room for 24 teams.
